Entries will be accepted from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM on Sunday, October 3, 2010 and will be released Sunday, October 3, 2010 at 8:00 PM
Exhibitors removing their animals from the barn prior to the posted release time shall forfeit all premiums and enobled herd book points.

Admission Tickets and Parking: See Director for admission & parking pass at check-in.

1. Percentage Boer Does

Special Attention: Make your entries early using the entry form in the back of this book. Space is assigned in the order entries are received and Show is limited to available tie space. **Entry fee is \$5 per head and no entries will be accepted after September 15th.**

SHOW RULES

General: ABGA Sanction Show Rules shall govern. The American Boer Goat Association will accept and permanently record all wins in shows that have been determined to have met all requirements (as stated below) for ABGA Sanction.

Entries: The Show is open to all exhibitors, but is **limited to 150 head** with entries accepted in the order they are received. There is no limit on the number of animals that can be entered in single entry classes by an exhibitor. However, no exhibitor may win more than two premiums in any given single entry class.

Eligibility of Animals: All goats must be registered in the herdbook of a recognized association before July 1, 2008. Recognized associations include ABGA, International Boer Goat Association, USBGA and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. Original registration certificates are required at check-in, though a copy of a Registration Application, stamped with the date received by one of the listed associations, will be accepted for kids less than 3 months of age. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before September 1, 2008. **All goats must be appropriately identified and comply with USDA Scrapie Eradication Program Guidelines. Ennobled Herd Book Points: Only goats entered under their ABGA registration number and presenting their ABGA Certificate of Registration will be eligible to earn points for their actual placing in the show as described in the ABGA "Criteria for Ennoblement of a Boer Goat."

Tattoos: All goats must have legible tattoos or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified. Point winners from each class must have their tattoos read and recorded. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.

Computing Ages: Birth dates, as listed on the registration certificate will be used to determine the class divisions. In order to calculate class breaks, take the show date and count back to the birth date to determine the age and the class for the animal.

Classes: All animals must be registered purebred, full blood or percentage blood Boer goats. Percentage doe classes are for goats 50% to 88%, Purebred/Full blood classes are for does that are 15/16 blood (94%) and higher 31/32 blood (97%) and higher for bucks. Progeny of fresh does will NOT be allowed in the ring. At the discretion of the judge and the superintendent, goats may be let loose in the ring as a function of judging. The Champion and Reserve Champion classes will be chosen from the division champions selected earlier in the Show.

Disqualification: Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from the show in any breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification as well as illegible tattoos or tattoos that are inconsistent with the goat's registration papers. Any doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed in the show.

Health: An official health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian or an NCDA&CS or USDA Veterinarian issued within 60 days of entry must accompany all out of state goats. This certificate must include:

1. Name and address of exhibitor.
2. Description of each animal including breed, age, sex, and any registration, tattoo or ear tag numbers.
3. A statement by the veterinarian signing the health certificate that the goats listed are not infected with, or have been recently exposed to, any communicable disease to the best of his/her knowledge. The health certificate shall contain a statement that the flock of origin has not had scrapie diagnosed within the past 42 months.
