- HH-2-4 Hybrid - White (5 ears) any named variety  
HH-2-5 Hybrid - Yellow (5 ears) any named variety  
HH-2-6 Open Pollinated, any variety

### GRAIN SORGHUM

**1st - \$5.00 2nd - \$4.00 3rd - \$3.00**

- HH-3-7 Milo (3 Heads any variety)

### SOYBEANS
