### RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All entries in this department must be the work of the individual exhibitor and exhibits must be produced during this year.
2. To be eligible for competition, worthy specimens of fruits and vegetables must be **characteristic of the variety, with stems attached, of high color, uniform, marketable size, free from cuts and bruises and all insect and disease blemishes.**
3. **PLATES:** Plates for the exhibits of fruits or vegetables will be furnished by the Fair.
4. **TRAYS:** The dimensions of trays are 11 x 18 x 3 inches. Approximately one peck to fill a tray. Trays furnished by fair.

### SCORE CARD

Premium for fruits and vegetables in trays and plates will be awarded according to the following score card:

Trueness to form .....	20 points
Size .....	10 points
Color .....	10 points
Uniformity .....	40 points
Condition (freedom from blemish) .....	20 points
<b>TOTAL.....</b>	<b>100 POINTS</b>
